

CONSTRUCTION NEWS

If the weather permits, there could be some work at the Smoke Road and SR 40 property this week! The architects have ordered a series of soil boring tests to be done on the land where our two new buildings will sit. The testing will consist of 53 borings. The architects will also have several borings taken in future roadways and parking lot locations. The depth of the tests will be approximately 25 feet at the building locations and 10 feet at drives and parking lots.

FYI - Soil boring is the process of using a drill rig to collect a soil sample from below the surface of the land. The resulting hole in the subsurface is also called a soil boring. By taking a soil boring, you can collect representative soil samples from below ground. The samples are then used to determine the suitability of the soil and assess whether the land can accommodate a construction project. SWL had a few soil borings taken when the land was originally purchased along with having a preliminary geotechnical study done in 2008. Due to the size of the project, a larger number of soil borings is needed.

We are still months away from moving dirt! Please share the above news, so that those who drive by can appreciate and understand what is happening.
