JUST THE FACTS

The Southwest Licking Local School District's currently uses fifteen (15) modular classrooms at the three existing elementary buildings to educate nearly 350 students daily. The following is a chart showing the design load versus the current enrollment of that building.

2016-17 Enrollment (August) / OFCC Master Plan Design Numbers = Capacity

Kirkersville	598 students currently enrolled / built for *458 students = 130.6% capacity
Pataskala	630 students currently enrolled / built for *459 students = 137.3% capacity
Etna	628 students currently enrolled / built for *426 students = 147.4% capacity
WMS	954 students currently enrolled / built for *691 students = 138.1% capacity
WMHS	1,253 students currently enrolled / built for *918 students = 136.5% capacity

*The above design plan numbers for each building are defined by the Ohio Facilities Construction Commission (OFCC) and are age specific. For example, one high school student is equivalent to 1.174 middle school students. This relationship causes our existing high school, once renovated and reprogrammed, to be able to accommodate 1,078 middle school students.
