

## Part 2 Additional Information: Competency

If a student attempts the ELA 2 and Algebra 1 exam at least twice and is unable to score 684 or higher on one or both exams, the student may use **one** of the options below to demonstrate competency.

### Complete Two Career-Focused Activities: At least one of the two must be a Foundational

#### Foundational Activities:

WebXams	Earn a score of proficient or higher on three or more WebXams in a single career pathway. 3 Options at WMHS: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Business: Business Foundations, Business Law, Business Management, Strategic Entrepreneurship</li> <li>2. Technology: Programming, Web Design, Game Design, Mobile Applications, Computer Science Discoveries</li> <li>3. Engineering: Robotics, Engineering Design, Engineering Principles, Machine Tools</li> </ol>
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Industry Credential	Some programs currently available at C-TEC
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Pre-Apprenticeship Program/Apprenticeship Program	Complete a pre-apprenticeship in the student’s chosen career field or, for students ages 18 and older, show evidence of acceptance into an apprenticeship program after high school.
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#### Supporting Activities:

Work-Based Learning	Complete a 250-hour work-based learning experience with evidence of positive evaluations. 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WorkKeys	Earn the workforce readiness score on WorkKeys-Earn a 3 or higher on each part and a total of 14 points: Applied Math, Graphic Literacy, and Workplace Documents tests
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Ohio Means Jobs Readiness Seal	A student must: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Demonstrate proficiency in each of 15 identified professional skills</li> <li>2. Use the OhioMeansJobs-Readiness Seal Form to record demonstration of each professional skill</li> <li>3. Work with a mentor to validate (confirm) each skill across a minimum of two of the three environments (school, work, community).</li> </ol>
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### Option 2

Enlist in the military: Provide to the school a signed copy of the Department of Defense Form Enlistment/Reenlistment (DD Form 4) enlistment contract.

### Option 3

Complete College Coursework: Earn credit for one college-level math and/or college-level English course through College Credit Plus. Credit must be earned in the subject area(s) in which the minimum score was not met on the state test.

## Part 3 Additional Information: Readiness-Demonstrated by earning 2 seals

### State-Defined Diploma Seals: (must earn at least one in this category)

<b>Military Enlistment Seal</b>	Provide to the school a signed copy of the Department of Defense Form Enlistment/Reenlistment (DD Form 4) enlistment contract.
<b>Technology Seal</b>	A student can: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Earn a score of 3 or higher on the appropriate AP exam: Computer Science A or Computer Science Principles</li> <li>2. Earn a final course grade that is equivalent to a "B" or higher in an appropriate CCP course</li> </ol>
<b>Industry-Recognized Credential Seal</b>	Earn a 12-point approved industry-recognized credential or group of credentials totaling 12 points in a single career field. Programs at C-TEC may offer this opportunity.
<b>Citizenship Seal</b>	A student can: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Earn a score of 3 or higher on both American History and American Government OST</li> <li>2. Earn a score of 3 or higher on the appropriate AP exam</li> <li>3. Earn a final course grade that is equivalent to a "B" or higher in appropriate CCP classes</li> </ol>
<b>Ohio Means Jobs Readiness Seal</b>	A student must: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Demonstrate proficiency in each of 15 identified professional skills</li> <li>2. Use the OhioMeansJobs-Readiness Seal Form to record demonstration of each professional skill</li> <li>3. Work with a mentor to validate (confirm) each skill across a minimum of two of the three environments (school, work, community)</li> </ol>
<b>State Seal of Biliteracy</b>	Meet the requirements and criteria, including proficiency requirements on assessments in a world language and English. Proficiency in world language is passing an AP world language exam with a score of 4 or higher. Proficiency in English language is earning proficient level on OST for English language arts or remediation-free scores on the English section of the ACT (18).
<b>Science Seal</b>	A student can: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Earn a score of 3 or higher on the Biology OST</li> <li>2. Earn a score of 3 or higher on the appropriate AP exam</li> <li>3. Earn a final course grade that is equivalent to a "B" or higher in an appropriate CCP class</li> </ol>
<b>Honors Diploma Seal</b>	Earn one of six Honors Diplomas below: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Academic Honors Diploma-Must meet all but one of the following criteria: 4 math credits, 4 social studies credits, 4 science credits including 2 units of Advanced Science, 1 credit fine art, 3 credits of same world language or two credits each of two world languages, 3.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale, ACT of 27 or higher/SAT of 1280 or higher</li> <li>2. International Baccalaureate Honors Diploma;</li> <li>3. Career-Tech Honors Diploma;</li> <li>4. STEM Honors Diploma;</li> <li>5. Arts Honors Diploma;</li> <li>6. <b>College-Ready Seal</b>	ACT English=18; Reading=22, Math=22 or SAT Reading/Writing=480 and Math=530

### Locally Defined Diploma Seals: (can only earn one seal in this category)

<b>Community Service Seal</b>	Students must document 60 hours through community service experiences. Student experiences may take place over 4 years of high school. Community service experiences must be pre-approved by a graduation team comprised of school counselors and administrative team.
<b>Student Engagement Seal</b>	Students must participate in 3 years/seasons of athletics, marching band, or pre-approved school sponsored club verified by the coach/advisor.
<b>Fine and Performing Arts Seal</b>	Students must complete 3 high school Fine Art courses (visual and/or performance).
