

The WorkKeys Assessment has 3 parts and students must earn a “3” on each part (out of 7).

- Applied Math
- Workplace Documents
- Graphic Literacy

Sign-in to your account, or click “Sign In” and then “Register Now” if a student needs to set up an account.

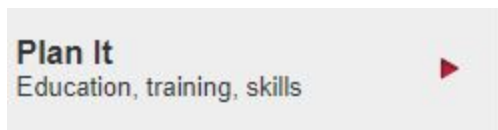
To access practice WorkKeys Assessments:

8. Take the ENTIRE test for EACH of the 3 sections...questions will seem easy at first, but get harder as you move through the test. A student must proceed through the “Level 1-3” questions successfully in order to score the “3” needed on each session. Don’t assume that the whole test is as easy as the first few questions and stop, because it’s not. Questions will get harder as you go, keep answering to the best of your ability since you won’t know when the Level 3 questions start/end!
