

## February:

1.) Property tax advances were lower than estimated as the school district did not receive advances from the Licking County Auditor. No other significant changes in receipts were noted.

2.) Significant expenditures for the month include: ESC deduction - \$74,622, Community school deduction - \$74,337, Scholarship deduction - \$69,314, Open enrollment - \$64,615, Electric - \$38,520, Certificated substitutes - \$34,830 (YTD FY20 - \$164,150, YTD FY19 - \$162,658), LACA internet services - \$33,137, Special education - \$29,313, Classified substitutes \$25,685 (YTD FY20 - \$144,927, YTD FY19 - \$153,457), College credit plus deduction - \$19,074, Fuel - \$16,826, and SRO services (2 months) - \$13,972.

## March (A Look Ahead):

1.) Property tax receipts will be higher as the school district will receive advances that were expected in February. No other significant changes in receipts are expected.

2.) Staff and benefits expenditures will be higher as there are three pay dates instead of two for the certificated staff. No other significant changes in expenditures are expected.
